2. Dancers must show 2019 FUSTA registration card
3. Trophy for most points in each class, except Primary. Cash awards for oldest premier section.
4. Premier Dancer of the Day on aggregate points if 6 in every group; otherwise dance off of first place winners.
5. Most Promising Beginner Trophy
6. Age groups will be divided according to entries received. Age is computed as of March 8, 2019.
8. Choreography is open to all dancers. Solos not to exceed 2 minutes, Duets and Groups not to exceed 3 minutes.
9. Due date for entries is March 3, 2019. Entries received after February 23 will not be listed in program

10. Make checks payable to SCOT. Mail entry to Registrar & include Self Addressed Stamped Envelope (SASE) .
11. Schedule of events will be determined based on entries and will be sent to participants prior to competition.
